I had so much fun I was able to convince my equally stage-shy wife Tessa to give it a go. She appeared with me (and Alex Dewar) in the one-act play **Variations on the Death of Trotsky**. (If you were confused by the play, imagine how we felt.)

The Gabriola Players 2013/14 season was extraordinary. Who would have guessed when the indomitable Dandelion convinced nine far-from-stage-shy women to perform **The Vagina Monologues** 10 years ago that we'd be where we are today?

A huge number of people have helped us with our success over the years, more than would fit in this entire newsletter – the many members who've worked on and off the stage to make our productions happen and the audiences who've embraced us and allowed us to continue expanding our horizons.


TIME TO RENEW YOUR MEMBERSHIP



NOVEMBER 2014








